"We wouldn't be without our RISO," she said. "Before, print was very plain. Delegate pack contents were printed on coloured paper to try to liven them up.

"We also used to have to outsource our annual reports but to keep costs as low as possible we would have to reduce the print run. Even then, it cost us over £900 just for 420 reports.

"With the new RISO, we can print much higher quantities, in colour, with a card cover when required and for a fraction of the price.

"We have the flexibility to reprint as and when we need to; there's no need to outsource or have stock of unused printed materials."
