Oakham Primary School, a 400+ pupil school.

Succeeding together is the strapline of Oakham Primary School, a setting that caters for more than 400 pupils in Oldbury, a market town in Sandwell, West Midlands.

School Business Manager Jess Clarke joined the staff at Oakham a couple of years ago, and took the opportunity to assess all contracts that were in place. She wasn't afraid to question the status quo.

The Challenge

A requirement for reliable, low-cost printing.

The school prints standard classroom materials and communications and does not have a requirement to produce hundreds of thousands of printed materials.

Even so, with two MFDs used by all staff, and a small office-based desktop printer, costs were more than £5,000 a quarter, with additional expense incurred if prints exceeded the agreed amount.

The Solution

Working with her IT technician, Jess looked around for a new supplier, with Jess knowing all about RISO having attended ISBL events (RISO is a trusted partner of ISBL).

Despite contracts not due for renewal until November 2021, RISO has already gone in and installed the compact FT5230 and FT5000 printers, which feature ultra-fast productivity and functionality, and extremely low power consumption providing for considerable energy savings and no air pollution. There is also a desktop printer solely for confidential use, and this was supplied through RISO too.

Jess calculates that the school saves more than £1,000 a quarter on rental alone, that's £4,000 a year. And even if they go above agreed print quantities, they will still be saving money.
